



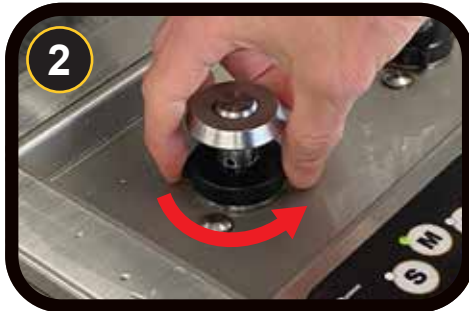
Bottoms Up Maintenance

DAILY CLEANING AFTER USE



1 REMOVE DRIP TRAY

Remove drip tray from dispenser and wash using non-chlorine and or non-amonia based solutions. Machine & hand wash safe.



2 REMOVE TAP HEADS

Remove each tap head by turning the black case nut counterclockwise



3 CLEAN TAP HEADS

Using a bucket of sani-water, dunk each tap head. While submerged, move the tap head ring up and down several times. Place to the side and let them air dry.

DO NOT SOAK TAP HEADS



4 RINSE DISPENSER

Using the bucket of sani-water, rinse of the dispenser drain pan, LEDs and exposed tap valves (cone heads).



5 WIPE DOWN DISPENSER

Using a clean, damp cloth, wipe down the dispenser. Start with the control pads, then body and finish with the drain pan.



6 REATTACH TAP HEADS

Reattach the tap heads using a clockwise motion until they are finger tight.

DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN

Quick Tip - countersinking can help catch the threads



7 REPLACE DRIP TRAY

Place your clean drip tray back into the drain pan.

CLEANING CHECKLIST

- Sani-water or similar non-amonia or non-chlorine based cleaning solution. Soda water will also work if done daily.
- Pitcher or bucket
- Clean cloth
